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B.S. DEGREE IN RISK MANAGEMENT/INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RISK MANAGEMENT/INSURANCE (RMI) MAJOR

2026-2027

Admission Requirements for the Risk Management/Insurance Major:

The Risk Management/Insurance major is a limited access program. To be admitted to the major, students must (1) have completed at least 52 semester hours, (2) have completed ACG 2021, ACG 2071, CGS 2100 or CGS 2518, ECO 2013, ECO 2023, MAC 2233, and STA 2023 with a grade of "C-" or better in each course, and (3) have the required overall GPA on all prior college level work that is in effect at the time they enter the major. **The overall GPA required for the 2026-2027 academic year (Fall 2026, Spring 2027, and Summer 2027) is 2.900. The overall GPA required is subject to change each academic year.**

Lower-level Prerequisites for RMI Majors: Students must earn a “C-” or better in each course. All of these courses must be completed prior to admission to the RMI major.

1. In addition to the requirements outlined above, each student must complete all University-wide requirements for graduation. These requirements include CoreFSU, summer residency, FSU residency, total hours, and Civic Literacy Requirement. University-wide requirements may differ by admissions term to FSU, please consult your advisor
2. The courses are structured so that students entering the major in the summer, fall, or spring should be able to complete all the RMI major course requirements one academic year after entering the major. Please be advised that business courses offered in the summer semester are extremely limited and RMI major specific courses are not offered in summer.
3. Qualified students may apply for the Combined Bachelor of Science in Risk Management/Insurance/Master of Science in Risk Management and Insurance (BS/MS-RMI) Pathway or in Risk Management/Insurance/Master of Business Administration (BS/MBA) Pathway. Students in the Combined BS/MS-RMI or BS/MBA Pathway can take up to nine hours of graduate work that may double count for their graduate and undergraduate degree requirements. Graduation requirements for graduate degrees programs differ from undergraduate degree programs. 4. Students **must not** enroll in **any** course at another institution without first receiving approval from the Herbert Wertheim College of Business Undergraduate programs Office. Once enrolled at FSU, students should plan to take their upper-level business courses at FSU. Any exception to this policy must be approved in advance by the Wertheim College Undergraduate Programs Office. Transfer of upper-level business courses completed prior to enrolling at FSU must be from business colleges at other 4-year, AACSB-accredited institutions. These courses must be approved for course substitution by the Wertheim College Undergraduate Programs Office upon entering FSU.
